



CALL FOR ENTRIES: The Women's Caucus Exhibition 2015: "Designed: Object, Subject, Environment"

The NAEA Women's Caucus is continuing its rich tradition of exhibiting member's works of art at the 2015 NAEA National Convention. Women's Caucus members are called to submit works of art relevant to the conference theme of "Designed: Object, Subject, Environment." **Works of art are digitally submitted by November 1, 2014 for jurying.** Artists of accepted works will be invited to speak about their art at the 2015 NAEA Convention. Accepted works of art will be included in an exhibition catalogue disseminated at the 2015 NAEA Convention's WC sessions in New Orleans. Women Caucus members may apply to the 2015 NAEA Women's Caucus Exhibition: Designed: Object, Subject, Environment, by submitting the following: **You need to be a current member of the NAEA Women's Caucus. If you are not, please visit <https://netforum.avectra.com/eweb/shopping/shopping.aspx?site=naea&cart=0>** and scroll down to the Women's Caucus button. You will need a gmail account. If you have a gmail account, please proceed to step 3. To create a "gmail" email account, go to <http://mail.google.com/>. From your gmail account, send a message to <mailto:elizabethjessiegarber@gmail.com> or to Catherine Chen at <mailto:wowcatherinechen@email.arizona.edu> with your name and a request to submit to the exhibition. You will receive a return email invitation to submit artwork.

In the invitation email, click on the link "Add photos." Upload 1-3 jpeg images of 300 dpi resolution by dragging them from their location on your home computer to the window on Picassa titled "Drag photos here." Alternatively, you may click on "Select photos from your computer" and add them. Please note that your images need to be 300 dpi, with a minimum dimension of 8" height or width. Because this is a print catalog, if your images are accepted, they will need to meet these minimum specifications.

To add text information, click on the photo and then click on "Add a caption" beneath the photo.

Text information must include: Artist name Artwork title Date completed Media and size For the first image, add an artist statement discussing the content related to the theme "Designed: Object, Subject, Environment." Your text needs to be limited to 150 words (or 1024 characters). **UPLOAD DEADLINE: November 1, 2014**
